The growth in the Indian steel sector has been driven by the domestic availability of raw materials such as iron ore and cost-effective labour. Consequently, the steel sector has been a major contributor to India's manufacturing output and employment generation in the country.

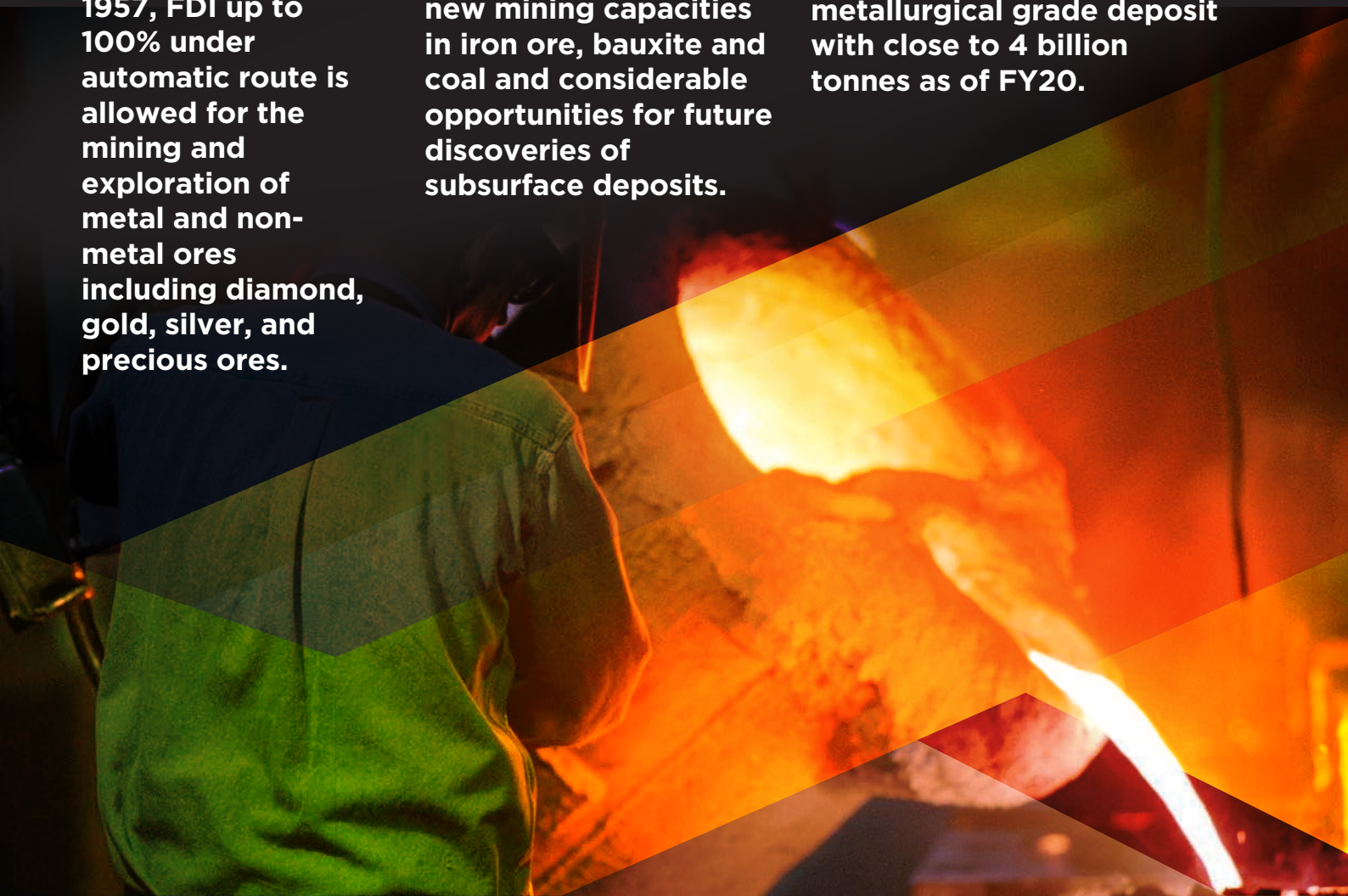
# **THE FOUNDATION OF A NEW INDIA**

Under the Mines and Minerals (Development and Regulation) Act of 1957, FDI up to 100% under automatic route is allowed for the mining and exploration of metal and non-metal ores including diamond, gold, silver, and precious ores.

As per Industry experts and economic observers, there is a significant scope for new mining capacities in iron ore, bauxite and coal and considerable opportunities for future discoveries of subsurface deposits.

The size of the Indian copper industry is around 6.6 lakh tons. India has emerged as a net exporter of copper from the status of being a net importer on account of this rising production.

According to the Ministry of Mines, India has the 4th largest bauxite reserves having high quality metallurgical grade deposit with close to 4 billion tonnes as of FY20.
